A Few Notes Before You Choose Your Fit Size

ON SIZING:

- All measurements are body measurements, not garment measurements. Think of them as the guide your dream outfit was stitched around.
- If you're between sizes, we recommend sizing up for comfort, especially with fitted silhouettes.
- For high-waist fits (hello snatched!), measure the narrowest part of your waist — usually 1–2 inches above your belly button.
- Our pieces are true to size, but always double-check the fabric and fit details on the product page — a flowy maxi and a bodycon mini won't hug you the same way.
- You're more than welcome to send in your own measurements — we love a custom fit moment.

ON DRESS LENGTHS:

- Mini Dress: Generally hits mid-thigh or slightly higher/lower.
- Midi Dress: Ends around the knee or mid-calf, depending on your height.
- Maxi Dress: Ankle or floor-grazing — for those dramatic entrances.
- Based on standard heights (approx. 5'4"–5'7"); actual fit may vary with height and style.
- All lengths are measured from the top of the shoulder to the bottom hem.
- These are approximate garment lengths — the exact fit may vary based on your height and the cut of the dress.

HOW TO MEASURE?

The Amós Way

Because you deserve a fit as perfect as your mirror selfies.

Grab a measuring tape (or your BFF), and let's get these digits. Because a perfect fit is the real main character energy.

Measuring tape = your style wand.

Tape it where it feels right, not just tight.

Bust:

Wrap the measuring tape around the fullest part of your bust, keeping it straight and snug — but not tight.

High Waist:

Measure around the smallest part of your waist, just above your belly button and below your ribcage.

Hips:

Stand straight and measure around the widest part of your hips and booty, keeping the tape parallel to the floor.

Dress Length:

Start at the top of your shoulder (near the neck) and measure straight down to where you want the dress to fall.
